**Re: *Proof of Claim Form for JCS Enterprises Inc., d/b/a JCS Enterprises Services Inc., T.B.T.I. Inc., My Gee Bo, Inc., JOLA Enterprises, Inc. and PSCS Holdings, LLC***

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to you as the Court-appointed Receiver for JCS Enterprises Inc., d/b/a JCS Enterprises Services Inc. ("JCS"), T.B.T.I. Inc. ("TBTI"), My Gee Bo, Inc. ("Gee Bo"), JOLA Enterprises, Inc. ("JOLA") and PSCS Holdings, LLC ("PSCS"), collectively referred to as the Receivership Entities. As you know, on April 7, 2014, the Court appointed me as Receiver for JCS and TBTI, and expanded the Receivership to include Gee Bo on April 14, 2014. The Court further expanded the Receivership to include JOLA and PSCS on December 11, 2014. I was reappointed as Receiver for the Receivership Entities by the Court on December 12, 2014. As Receiver, my Court-ordered responsibilities include, among other things, marshalling assets of the Receivership Entities and making a Court-approved distribution to eligible investors and creditors. As part of the first step in the process of ultimately distributing assets of the Receivership Entities, the Court approved the enclosed document named the "Proof of Claim Form." This document may also be found on the Receivership Entities' website located on the Internet at [www.jcs-tbtireceivership.com](http://www.jcs-tbtireceivership.com).

The Proof of Claim Form contains instructions to complete it and submit a claim. I strongly urge you to carefully read and follow all of the Proof of Claim Forms' instructions. Most importantly, if you believe that you may have a claim and in order to have your claim considered, you **MUST** deliver a completed and signed Proof of Claim Form (that provides complete responses to all of the questions in the Proof of Claim Form and attaches all of the requested documents) to: **Office Manager, Sallah Astarita & Cox, LLC, 2255 Glades Rd., Ste. 300E, Boca Raton, Florida 33431 on or before 5:00 p.m. on November 27, 2017 (the "Claims Bar Date")**. You must do so, even if such claim is not now mature, fixed, liquidated or certain, or does not become mature, fixed, liquidated, or certain before the Claims Bar Date. Failure to timely return a completed and signed Proof of Claim Form will forever bar any claim. Moreover, altered forms will not be accepted. If you have already provided the Government, another person, and/or my counsel's office with a completed claim form and/or any documents, you **MUST** still deliver a completed and signed Proof of Claim Form (that provides complete responses to all of the questions in the Proof of Claim Form and attaches all of the requested documents) to the address

above on or before the Claims Bar Date. For purposes of the claims process and my review, I will NOT consider any forms and/or documents that you have provided previously to any person or entity prior to the date of this letter.

I have tried to make the Proof of Claim Form as simple and nonintrusive as possible. However, I must ensure that **only** legitimate claims are submitted to the Court for approval. Therefore, please be truthful in submitting your claim. You must swear under penalty of perjury that the claim you submit is true and correct. If the claimant is not an individual, an authorized agent must sign under penalty of perjury. Each Proof of Claim Form must be legible, written in English, and denominated in United States currency.

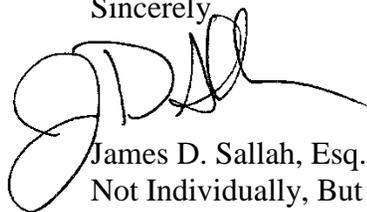
My goal, of course, is to maximize the amount of distributions to the Receivership Entities' legitimate investors and creditors. At this point, it is still too early to predict how much money will ultimately be available for distribution or who will be eligible to receive a distribution. In addition, the amount of your recovery (if you have a legitimate and allowed claim) will depend on the total amount of submitted and allowed legitimate investor and creditor claims, how much you may have already received from the Receivership Entities or third-parties, and the Court's approval. I will not be able to determine the above issues until after the Claims Bar Date and the Court has approved a claims process or procedure.

Please remain patient during the claims process. It will take me and my team many months to analyze the voluminous Proof of Claim Forms that we expect to receive and to make recommendations to the Court, which ultimately decides whether to accept or deny each individual claim. In the future, I will be filing a motion with the Court seeking approval of a proposed claims process/procedure and posting such motion on the Receivership Entities' website. The future motion will, among other things, list the claims that I recommend that the Court accept (and approve payment) and the claims that I recommend that the Court deny (and reject payment, whether in whole or in part, and whether permanently or temporarily). It will also address the procedure for resolving and/or litigating the claims to which I object and recommend that the Court deny.

Please note that if you fail to: 1) follow all instructions on the Proof of Claim Form; 2) fully complete the Proof of Claim Form; 3) attach all requested documents; 4) sign under penalty of perjury as an authorized person, I will have no choice other than to object to your claim and recommend that the Court deny it, in whole or in part. This will only delay the claims process.
